Binder looked ahead to the new season saying, "My target for the season is podium finishes. It is going to be a very difficult championship. Danilo added, "Training downhill with a mountain bike has been real fun. Unfortunately, before enjoying it you have to go all the way uphill... not mentioning the rest of our training program. Now, I feel fit and ready in a way I could not believe before. I'm looking forward to comparing myself to the others in the last test and even more in the first race, to see our potential. It's going to be an exciting season."
